

DMCA Policy

The Old Time Radio Researchers organization (“OTRR”) respects the intellectual property rights of others and expects its members to do the same. In accordance with the Digital Millennium Copyright Act of 1998, the text of which may be found on the U.S. Copyright Office website at <http://www.copyright.gov/legislation/dmca.pdf>, OTRR will respond expeditiously to claims of copyright infringement committed by group members in preparing a series for official release by the group that are reported to the Old Time Radio Designated Copyright Agent identified in the sample notice below.

OTRR reserves the right to “Fair Use” copyrighted materials, as defined by the DMCA in any of its archival certified series, and will give credit, where known, to the copyright holder.

Any claims of copyright infringement are to be made directly to the Old Time Radio Researchers organization and not to a third party. Such claims will be ignored by the Old Time Radio Researchers organization.

The copyright holder is required to identify themselves by the corporate name and address, and if a complaint is made by someone not the copyright holder, they are required to indicate the relationship, if any, to the copyright holder the complainant has.

If you are a copyright owner, authorized to act on behalf of one or authorized to act under any exclusive right under copyright, please report alleged copyright infringements taking place on behalf of the organization (“OTRR”) by completing the following DMCA Notice of Alleged Infringement and delivering it to the Old Time Radio Designated Copyright Agent. Upon receipt of Notice as described below, the Old Time Radio Researchers will take whatever action, in its sole discretion, it deems appropriate, including removal of the challenged use of materials from any official certified archival set, provided such claims are valid.

DMCA Notice of Alleged Infringement ("Notice")

- Identify the copyrighted work that you claim has been infringed, or - if multiple copyrighted works are covered by this Notice - you may provide a representative list of the copyrighted works that you claim have been infringed.
- Identify the material or link you claim is infringing (or the subject of infringing activity) and that access to which is to be disabled, including at a minimum, if applicable, the URL of the link shown on the relevant website where such material may be found.
- Provide your mailing address, telephone number, and, if available, email address.

- Include both of the following statements in the body of the Notice:

"I hereby state that I have a good faith belief that the disputed use of the copyrighted material is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law (e.g., as a fair use)."

"I hereby state that the information in this Notice is accurate and, under penalty of perjury, that I am the owner, or authorized to act on behalf of the owner, of the copyright or of an exclusive right under the copyright that is allegedly infringed."

- Provide your full legal name and your electronic or physical signature.
